

**AGREEMENT ON PARTNERSHIP,
COOPERATION, AND SCIENTIFIC EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
UBON RATCHATHANI UNIVERSITY (THAILAND)
AND
TOYOHASHI UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (JAPAN)**

Ubon Ratchathani University (Thailand) and Toyohashi University of Technology (Japan) (from now on referred to as “parties”), recognizing the necessity of widening scientific contacts and partnerships between institutes of research and higher education in Thailand and Japan, agree as follows:

PART 1

Based on the principles of respect for each other’s independence and mutual benefit, the Ubon Ratchathani University and Toyohashi University of Technology will collaborate in a wide variety of research subjects in Science and Technology, Agriculture, and Engineering. Forms of collaboration will include the following activities:

- (1) Exchange of work experience, scientific materials, publications, and information about research projects
- (2) Joint educational and research projects and research meetings
- (3) Exchange of faculty members, staff, and students.

PART 2

To carry out the above-mentioned activities, a detailed working plan is to be formed after consultation between the parties.

PART 3

Financial relationships of the parties will be in accord with planning and organization of specific arrangements.



PART 4

This agreement on partnership, cooperation, and scientific exchange will remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving three (3) months written notice to the other party. Otherwise it will be renewed by mutual consent of the parties for a new period of five (5) years.

This agreement may be amended with the consent of the parties through a written Addendum executed by authorized individuals of the parties.

This agreement is drawn up in the English language and two copies are signed by representatives of each party. One of these copies is to be kept by each party.

**AGREEMENT ON COVERING THE IMPLEMENTATION
OF A STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM
BETWEEN
UBON RATCHATHANI UNIVERSITY (THAILAND)
AND
TOYOHASHI UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (JAPAN)**

Ubon Ratchathani University and Toyohashi University of Technology agree to implement a student exchange program based on this Agreement concluded between the two institutions.

1. The purpose of this exchange program is to provide opportunities for the students of each institution to gain international experience by completing a part of their education in the foreign host institution.
2. Both institutions shall accept not more than five (5) exchange students each for a period of up to one (1) year. Exchanges should be reciprocal and balanced over the duration of this agreement. In the case of an anticipated imbalance, either party may suspend or reduce intake or outflow of students to establish the balance.
3. Notification about plans for sending or accepting students will be made by each institution before the agreed deadline, and that acceptance of students shall be guided by the regulations and procedures set by the host institution.
4. The students will have the status of "Exchange Students" and will remain as students of the home institution. The host institution will award credits to the students who registered in and attended classes, and attained examination results above the prescribed levels. Upon request of the home institution, the professors of the host institution who acted as the supervisors of the exchange students will make reports on the students' performances. However, the home institution still has the right to make the final decisions on whether or not academic credits will be awarded to the students.
5. Both institutions will waive the application, registration, and tuition fees of the exchange students at the host university (they still pay tuition fees, if applicable, at their home university).
6. Both institutions will assist the exchange students in satisfying visa requirements and appropriate immigration documents. Exchange students will be required to join the health insurance program.
7. Both institutions will not be obliged to guarantee the exchange students' accommodation. However, the host institution will be responsible for assisting the students to find safe and secure accommodation.
8. Except for the applications, registrations, and tuition fees, all other expenses incurred during the program, such as travel expenses and living expenses,

will be borne by the participants. Also, health insurance costs will be paid by the students.


9. Further details of specific conditions, other than those described here, will be worked out through ad hoc mutual consultation.
10. This agreement will be valid from the date last signed below for a period of five years. After each five years, it will be renewed by mutual consent of the parties for a new period of five years, unless either party wishes to end the Agreement and informs the other party of such a decision in writing at least six months prior to the end date.


