

**Memorandum of Understanding
between
Far East University
Eumseong, Chungbuk, Republic of Korea
and
Ubon Ratchathani University, Thailand**

To promote educational, scientific, and cultural exchange for the purpose of broadening the learning environment for faculty, students, and staff, Far East University (FEU) and the Ubon Ratchathani University (UBU) agree to pursue the following under this Memorandum of Understanding:


1. To promote joint faculty and academic program development and Joint educational and cultural programs
2. To promote the exchange of academic materials, publications and information
3. To develop student and faculty exchange programs
4. To prepare, as necessary, a working program detailing specific forms and content of cooperation

Nothing in this Memorandum of Understanding is intended to create a commitment of financial resources or legal relationship between the two signatories. All activities must be mutually agreed to by both institutions. All representations made by either party with respect to this agreement must be done after consultation with the other party.


This Memorandum of Understanding comes into force on the day of signature by the authorized signatory of each party and remains in force for an initial period of five years, after which it may be renewed. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving the other party at least six months' written notice.
