



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
BETWEEN
DIVISION OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS
UBON RAJATHANEE UNIVERSITY
AND
COLLEGE OF LANGUAGES, LINGUISTICS, AND
LITERATURE
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MĀNOA**



Ubon Rajathanee University Division of International Relations in the Kingdom of Thailand and **University of Hawaii at Mānoa College of Languages, Linguistics, and Literature** agree to promote the exchange of faculty, scholars and students in the belief that the research and educational processes at both universities will be enhanced and that mutual understanding between their respective faculty, scholars and students will be increased. Both parties agree to the following activities:

1. Exchange of personnel (students, and academic and administrative staff)
2. Collaborative staff development programs
3. Exchange of academic information and materials of mutual interest
4. Organization of joint research programs
5. Other academic exchanges agreed to by both parties.

Details of any academic cooperation resulting from this MOU will be negotiated and determined in the form of a contract signed by both parties.

All activities resulting from this MOU will be governed by and in accordance with the laws of Thailand and the United States of America. All agreements and obligations of the parties are subject to the procurement and maintenance of all applicable government consents, permits, authorizations, and approvals.

This MOU is valid for five years from the last date of signature below and is subject to revision and renewal by mutual consent. Either party may terminate the MOU at any time by written notice signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. The notice must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination. This agreement shall take effect from the date of the signatures below.
