



COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
by and between
UBON RATCHATHANI UNIVERSITY
and
THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY

This letter of understanding is made and entered into by and between The Florida State University Board of Trustees, located in Tallahassee, Florida, United States of America for the benefit of The Florida State University, and Ubon Ratchathani University, Mukdahan Campus, located in Mukdahan, Thailand. The parties hereto agree as follows.

I. Philosophical Intent

a. The primary objective of this agreement is the development of cooperative efforts between The Florida State University and Ubon Ratchathani University, Mukdahan Campus which will enhance the academic interchange between the two institutions. Recognizing the importance of mutual collaboration and the contributions to society made by institutions of higher education, the parties desire to promote the interchange of academic and research information as well as support visits between faculty and researchers (students not enrolled for credit at the host university).

b. Specific projects in an area of educational interest will be selected as a result of coordination by The Florida State University and Ubon Ratchathani University, Mukdahan Campus at the appropriate

administrative level in each institution. As these projects are developed, each will require a specific written agreement made in advance, setting forth the terms and conditions thereof and executed by authorized representatives of both institutions. In the event a decision is made to exchange students who will be enrolled at the host university, an International Agreement for Reciprocal Student Exchange Program will be developed.

II. General Provisions


a. All research and other collaborative activities conducted pursuant to this agreement shall be conducted in accordance with the laws and regulations appropriate to each institution. In the case of The Florida State University, these include the laws of the United States of America and of the State of Florida, and the rules and regulations of the Florida Board of Governors and The Florida State University Board of Trustees. In the case of Ubon Ratchathani University, Mukdahan Campus these are the laws of Thailand and the rules and regulations of Ubon Ratchathani University. Any exchange of technical information and technology under this International Cooperative Agreement or other agreement will be subject to Thai and the United States of America export control laws and regulations.

b. This agreement shall take effect when executed by the parties and shall terminate five years from the date of signing. The agreement may be renewed or amended by written mutual agreement. This agreement may be terminated by either party by giving 60 days written notice to the other party.



d. Any funding required for this Agreement is subject to appropriations by the Legislature of the State of Florida and Thai laws for this purpose.




