

GENERAL INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENT


THAILAND - AUSTRALIA

The Ubonratchathani University and the University of South Australia do hereby enter into an agreement to promote international cooperation in education and research. This is based on the principles of equality and reciprocal benefit.

Both Universities agree to pursue cooperation under the terms and conditions identified in this Agreement.

- The Agreement covers the following activities. These do not exclude the possibility of additional activities which might be separately agreed:
 - Collaborative research projects
 - Collaborative staff development programs
 - Exchange of staff and students
 - Exchange of publications, reports and other academic information
- The Agreement specifies general areas of potential cooperation. It is understood that the enactment of the Agreement shall require a specific Memorandum of Understanding identifying the conditions governing a nominated activity.
- The Agreement shall be effective from the date of signature by the representative of each University who is competent to sign on behalf of that Institution.
